

## RULES

1. All honey and wax must be the produce of the exhibitor's own bees.
2. Entry forms with S.A.E. must reach the Show Secretary by the Friday 9<sup>th</sup> July.
3. Exhibitors may make only one entry in a class, but can only take one award, which will be counted for points for Challenge Trophies.
4. Honey must be exhibited in clear 454g (1 lb) squat jars of British Standard Pattern with standard lacquered or plastic screw tops.
5. Labels will be supplied and must be affixed to exhibits as follows:  
jars and mead bottles – 15mm (½ in) from the bottom  
beeswax – one on upper surface of the wax displayed  
small blocks of wax – a label on one side of each block  
photographs – mounted colour print photograph about bees or beekeeping, for the general public (non-beekeeper). There should be a title or caption. Photographs to have been taken by the exhibitor and mounted on plain, Tinted or coloured card, A4 size.
6. Beeswax must be plainly moulded and not exhibited in boxes. All will be placed in a display stand.
7. Mead to be shown in a clear punted bottle with little or no lettering or ornamentation containing approximately 750ml (27 fluid oz). Only cork stoppers with white plastic flanges to be used.
8. Exhibits will be accepted at the Show from 2pm – 6pm on the day prior to the Show opening and from 8am – 9am on the morning of the first day. They will be staged by the appointed stewards. Judging starts at 10.00am and exhibits may only be removed after 5.30pm on the last day of the Show.
9. All exhibits except those in the Gift Classes will remain the property of the exhibitor. All reasonable care will be taken with the exhibits but the Show Committee cannot be responsible for any loss or damage. All exhibitors in the show, with the exception of class 8, are expected to enter either class 15 or 16.
10. Any points not covered in the above rules will be referred to the rules applying to the National Honey Show.

Points awarded: First – 6, Second – 5, Third – 4, VHC – 3, HC – 2, C – 1

## SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

### OPEN TO ALL BEEKEEPERS

Entry forms must reach the Show Secretary by Friday July 9<sup>th</sup> 2010

### OPEN CLASSES

#### Open to any beekeeper.

1. Two jars of Light Coloured Honey
2. Two jars of Medium Coloured Honey
3. Two jars of Dark Coloured Honey
4. Two jars of Naturally Crystallised or Soft Set Honey
5. Six jars of one type of Honey (Light, Medium, Dark, Crystallised or Soft Set), labelled as offered for sale including Country of origin and best before date (*Rule 4 does not apply*)
6. One cake of Beeswax, weight between 200-255g (7-9oz) and not less than 20mm ( $\frac{3}{4}$  in) thick
7. One bottle of Mead (*Rules 5 & 7*)
8. Mounted Colour Print Photograph with Title relating to Bees or Beekeeping. Taken by the exhibitor and mounted on plain, tinted or coloured card 250 x 200mm (10 x 8ins). Digital images are permitted.
9. 3 Beeswax Candles. Candles need not necessarily be the same size or style. The display will be judged on its artistic merits. They will **not** be lit. (*Rules 1 & 6 do not apply*)

### INTERMEDIATE CLASSES

**Open to beekeepers, who have not been awarded a 1<sup>st</sup> prize for honey at the Kent Show in the last 3 years.**

10. Two jars of Light Coloured Honey
11. Two jars of Medium Coloured Honey
12. Two jars of Dark Coloured Honey
13. Two jars of Naturally Crystallised or Soft Set Honey

### NOVICE CLASSES

**Open to Beekeepers who have never won First Prize for honey.**

14. Two jars of Honey, any one colour.
15. Two jars of honey, Naturally Crystallised or Soft Set.

**HONEY GIFT CLASSES 16 & 17** Please supply one of your own labels in an envelope with your entry number on it which can be applied when the honey is sold.

16. One jar of Clear Honey, any colour
17. One jar of Crystallised or Soft Set Honey
